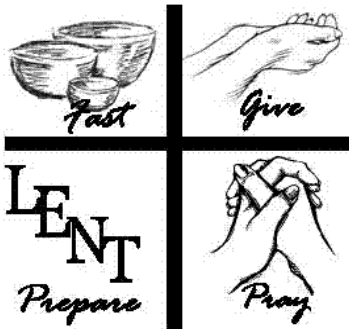

Lent

Today is Ash Wednesday which marks the beginning of the season of Lent. Ash Wednesday occurs 46 days before Easter. It's the beginning of Lent, which represents the 40 days Jesus spent fasting in the desert. Lent is a time of preparation for Easter. This is a period of prayer, fasting and consideration of others.
