PRINCIPAL'S MESSAGE

K-6 Maths

Part of our Annual Improvement Plan for 2020 was to further refine our K-6 Maths. The idea behind K-6 Maths is to allow the teachers to tailor individual programs for each of our students across the school. During our daily Maths time we run 4 groups across the 2 classrooms. We have an Early Stage 1 and Stage 1 group with Miss Kelly and Mrs Walters, a Stage 2 group with Mrs Elks and Mrs Hull and a Stage 3 group with Mrs Finlayson.

Before each new Maths topic, we pre-test all our students to find out what they can do. We plot them along the continuum (sequence of learning) and then place them into the group that suits their needs. This allows for our students to be taught "the right content at the right time." Our Maths space is organised so that students can move from one group to another with each new topic and be taught content that they require when they require it.

Our students are making great progress and are enjoying the more personalised approach to their learning.
