

St Vincent de Paul Mass

Come and celebrate midday Mass for the feast day of St Vincent de Paul with us on Friday 27th of September. The students will wear "muffi" on the day and our Mini Vinnies students will collect a gold coin donation for their Term 4 Christmas campaign.

Seven Amazing Facts About St Vincent de Paul

1. Vincent went into the priesthood with the aim to retire and live comfortably : little did he know what God had planned for him.
2. He was kidnapped : In 1605, he left to go on a mission trip. On the way, he was captured, shipped to Tunis, and sold as a slave for two years.
3. He was accused of theft : St. Vincent was falsely accused of theft by his roommate. He didn't care about his public image and did not defend himself. The real thief finally confessed years later.
4. The confession of a dying man changed his life : it led him to the poor and to recruit more priests!
5. He was a man with a temper : he often prayed that God would slow his anger.
6. His body is Incorrupt : St. Vincent's bones and heart are perfectly incorrupt. His relics can be seen in the Church of St. Vincent de Paul in Paris.
7. St. Vincent de Paul did not found the St. Vincent de Paul Society : it was actually Blessed Frédéric Ozanam, an admirer of the saint, who founded the Society of St. Vincent de Paul in 1833, in his honor.

Grandparents Day




